

GeoTools moves to OSGeo Hardware

The GeoTools project has moved repositories today - to hardware maintained by the Open Source Geospatial Foundation.

We would like to thank Refrations Research for giving us a home for the last five years (they kindly provided an svn repository for us when Source Forge was going through some growing pains in 2003).

The new hardware is faster and has a better connection which will result in a faster build time for those building with maven.

The new code repository is located here

To migrate an existing checkout to this new location please use:

```
svn switch --relocate http://svn.geotools.org/ http://svn.osgeo.org/geotools .
```

or

```
svn switch --relocate http://gtsvn.refrations.net/ http://svn.osgeo.org/geotools .
```

This move also opens up a new maven repository (used to host the compiled geotools artifacts so other projects can use them). If needed you can add the following to your maven pom.xml:

```
<repositories>
  <repository>
    <id>osgeo</id>
    <name>Open Source Geospatial Foundation Repository</name>
    <url>http://download.osgeo.org/webdav/geotools/</url>
  </repository>
  ...
</repositories>
```
